TRANSITIONS



Transitions help organize your text and serve as a guide for your reader. They can be used between phrases, sentences or paragraphs.





To indicate sequence: first, second, third, next, then, subsequently, finally

Deciding what transition to use will depend on the content and purpose of your text.





To indicate cause and effect: consequently, therefore, thus, hence, accordingly, due to, since

To indicate contrast:
however, despite,
nevertheless,
meanwhile, on the other
hand, yet, but





To indicate similarity: likewise, similarly, also, in like manner

To illustrate: for instance, specifically, for example, in this case, in particular



To add: furthermore, moreover, in addition
