Grammar and Usage

- Usage: The usage tool is helpful whenever a word belongs to different syntactic categories. Example: "answer"
 - I want an **answer**. (noun)
 - **Answer** me now! (verb)
- Collocation: The collocations tool will help you see the same word in many sentences or phrases which will help you grasp how it is usually used and what types of words usually come before or after it. Example: prepositions
 - responsible **for**
 - responsible **to**

Usage

If you look up the word "enable," Word Reference will provide with a few synonyms that are used in a similar way. For example, "permit" and "allow" are synonyms of "enable" and should be followed by an object and a to-infinitive clause. Then, it shows what the verb looks like in example sentences.

allow - permit - let - enable

Allow, permit, and **let** are all used to say that someone is given permission to do something, or is not prevented from doing something. Permit is a formal word.

1 'allow' and 'permit'

Allow and permit are followed by an object and a to-infinitive clause.

He allowed me to take the course.

They do not permit students to use calculators in exams.

You can say that people **are not allowed to** do something or **are not permitted to** do something.

Visitors are not allowed to take photographs in the museum.

Children are not permitted to use the swimming pool.

You can also say that something **is not allowed** or that it **is not permitted**.

Running was not allowed in the school.

Picnics are not permitted in the park.

2 'let'

Let is followed by an object and an infinitive without to.

Collocations

"Collocation" refers to word placement in different parts of a sentence according to the word's function.

For collocations of the word "enable," Word Reference provides eleven phrases in which the word is used in different contexts.

The verb conjugator tool is available in four languages and provides a full table with all possible conjugations for each verb.

The table that follows provides the conjugations of the verb "enable."

The table is divided in **verb tense** and **person** so you can easily find the verb conjugation that fits into your sentence.

enable
