




Basic Essay Format APA (7th Edition) Part 1





- works, you may need to include a short version of the paper's title in the header after the cover page (all capitalized).
- You may need to divide your paper into parts and include titles and subtitles for every section. Titles should be centered and in bold, while subtitles should be left-justified and in bold.
- Double spaced.


