Rules



Overall Layout

- One inch margins from all sides.
- Font: Times New Romans
- Size: 12pt.
- Use 1/2 inch indent for every new paragraph.
- Use left-justified to organize your text.
- Double-space text.



2



- Cover pages are single spaced.
 - Write your title half-way through the page, centered.
 - For subtitle, write a colon at the end of your title and continue on the next line.

Write your name, professor's name, course's title, and date. Everything should be centered.





<u>Pages</u>

- Number all pages sequentially (Last name is recommend to be included).
- Double spaced.
- 1/2 inch indent at the start of paragraphs.





<u>Bibliography</u>

- Write "Bibliography" at the top of the page centered.
- Every entry should follow Chicago guidelines.
- All entries need to have a hanging indentation.
- Double spaced text.
- For the order of information, search for our infographic.
